1.2 ADMISSION

2.0 SCHOOLS FACILITIES

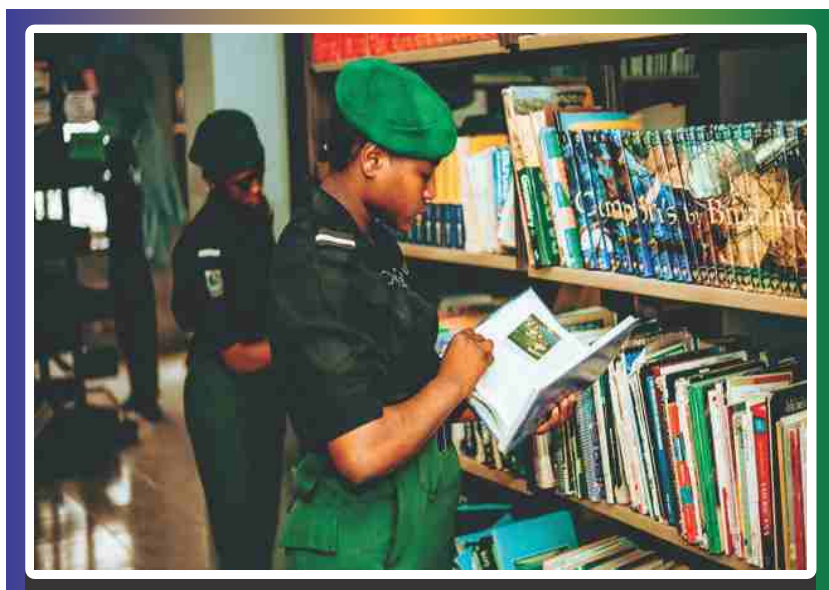
2.1 CLASSROOMS

The schools are equipped with adequate and Modern Learning Facilities. The Teacher-Student ratio is in line with UNESCO Standards. Some schools are also equipped with Audio-Visual facilities.



2.2 LIBRARIES

The school libraries are well stocked with up-to-date text books and other learning materials, while the unit is moving to the establishment of e-libraries in Police Secondary Schools as it is in PSS Minna, Niger State. Students are allowed into the libraries during free periods where they carry out their independent studies.

2.3 LABORATORIES

Our Schools are well equipped with Laboratories for Sciences, Languages, Home Economics, ICT as well as other Vocational/ Entrepreneurial Skills Centres.

The laboratories are managed by qualified and competent Laboratory Scientists and Technicians.



2.4 CLINICS

There are qualified Medical Personnel in the schools who manage the Clinics. The Clinics are equipped with beds, drugs and other medical equipment to cater for staff and students' health and well-being. There is also a quick referral system to nearby hospitals

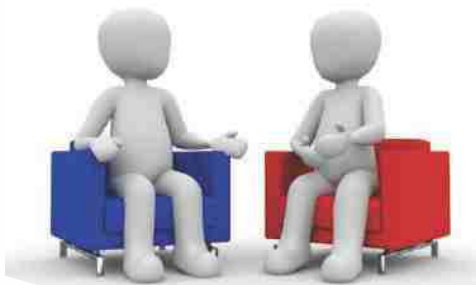


► SCHOOL CLINIC, PSS TUM-KAGORO



2.5 GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING

Professional School Guidance Counselors are always available to Support the Academic Careers, Personal and Social Development of our students. In all our co-educational schools, there are Male Counselors for Boys and Female Counselors for Girls.



2.6 BOARDING FACILITIES

Our Boarding facilities such as Hostels, Dining Halls, Common Rooms, etc. are well equipped in top sanitary conditions with in-house Porters to take care of the students at all times.

The dining halls are well equipped and hygienic. Balanced diets are always served to keep the students strong and healthy.

All Schools have adequate power and water supply, powered by the National Grid, Solar Power and Bore-holes.



2.7 SPORTS & PARADES

Police Secondary Schools have Football fields, Tennis Courts and other Sports facilities. Students are encouraged to take part in sports and master at least a game. There are designated times for sporting activities in the schools and every student must be available for this.

2.6 HOSTELS

The hostels are very spacious and conducive for healthy living. All hostels have good and neat toilets with constant supply of water. There are boreholes and overhead tanks to conserve water for use at all times

2.8 EXAMINATION AND ACADEMIC RECORDS

Students are frequently assessed through Academic Evaluations. Continuous Assessments and Examinations are conducted termly. Students performance across multiple assessments and terms are aggregated to create Cumulative Results, which is used to determine if a student deserves to be promoted to the next class.

Every Student is expected to obtain a minimum Cumulative Average Score of 50% to merit promotion to the next class.



2.9 RELIGIOUS ACTIVITIES

The school does not compel students to any form of worship, but we teach our students the way of God by giving them exhortation during assemblies.

In addition to this, Christian and Muslim students are permitted to form Associations and elect their leaders who organize and lead them in religious activities and prayers.

3.0 CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Clubs and Societies are essential parts of our Schools Curriculum. They are designed to take learning outside the Core Curriculum Environment where learners can through different activities harness their talents, build lifelong skills, choose/select their carriers and learn how to support one another.

3.1 HAIRCUT / PLAITING

Male/Female Students are not permitted to keep long and bushy hair. The schools therefore engage the services of Barbers/Hair Stylists who organize plaiting and haircuts for them on Saturdays. These Barbers/Hair Stylists always come to the school compound since the students are not allowed to go out.

3.2 VISITING DAY

Parents are allowed to visit their children/wards on the first Saturday of the last month of the school calendar. During this period, parents have the opportunity review their children/wards school academic work.

3.3 ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES

After passing the Common Entrance Examination and being Offered Admission into Police Secondary School, there are still procedures to fulfill before this admission is confirmed. These procedures are;

1. A Comprehensive Medical Test.
2. Purchase of stipulated and necessary materials.
3. Complete payment of School Fees and Other Charges.

Welcome! As a newly admitted student, your account has already been set up by the school on the NPFEDU platform (powered by GSIMS). Kindly follow the instructions below to log in and complete your school fees payment securely and efficiently:

Step 1: Download the NPFEDU App

Go to the Google Play Store (for Android users) or the Apple App Store (for iPhone users).

Search for “NPFEDU”.

On the App Store, the app is listed as “GoMobile School App”. However, searching for “NPFEDU” will still bring it out.

Download and install the app on your mobile device.

Step 2: Select 'Parents' and Log In

Launch the app and select “Parents” as your user type.

Enter your Exam Number as both your Username and Password.

Tap “Login” to access your dashboard.

Step 3: Open the Menu

On the home screen, tap the middle button at the bottom of the screen to access the Menu Page.

Step 4: Access the Fees Section

Tap on “Fees” to open the Make Payment page.

Click on the “Pay” button to view a detailed breakdown of your school fees.

Tap “Make Payment”.

Enter a valid email address. Your payment receipt will be sent to this address.

Step 5: Complete Your Payment

There are two available payment options. Please follow the appropriate steps for your chosen method:



- **Option 1: Pay with Card**

This method allows you to complete payment directly within the app using your debit card (Visa, Verve, or Mastercard):

1. Select “Pay with Card”.
2. Enter your card number, expiry date, and CVV.
3. Confirm the payment using the OTP sent by your bank.
4. Once successful, wait for a prompt to download your receipt.
5. Tap the message to open the Payment Status page and click the arrow icon to download your receipt.
6. The receipt will also be sent to your email.
7. Present this receipt at the school gate for access.

- **Option 2: Choose Other Payment Method**

This method redirects you to your browser for payment using options like bank transfer or USSD:

1. Select “Choose Other Payment Method”.
2. Your browser will open with a list of alternative payment channels.
3. Choose your preferred option and complete the transaction.
4. Return to the NPFEDU app after a successful payment.
5. A notification confirming successful payment will appear.
6. Tap the notification to open the Payment Status page.
7. Click the arrow icon to download your receipt, also sent to your email.
8. Present this receipt at the school gate for access.

Step 6: Receipt Confirmation & School Access

All receipts are available under the 'Payment Status' section of the app. Ensure you either print or save the receipt from your email or the app. You must present the receipt at the school gate to gain entry.
